Computer and Information Systems Managers, often referred to as Information Technology (IT) Managers, plan coordinate, and direct computerrelated activities within an organization. They help determine the IT goals of an organization, and are responsible for established IT teams and that computer and information systems implementations meet said goals. This position thus requires both technical knowledge, as well as exceptional leadership capabilities. Computer and Information Systems Managers would train and inspect the work of IT staff members, and take a role themselves in offering quality technical support services. They would also meet with vendors and other company managers to resolve systems issues or malfunctions.


